## **CITY OPERATIONS UPDATE**

(UPDATED 9:14am 3/25/20)

- The City of Hallandale Beach is operating under <a href="Emergency Declaration 20-03">Emergency Declaration 20-03</a> issued March 24, 2020. This Emergency order includes a **nightly curfew** from 11pm to 5am until further notice. Please stay home and off the road. Only essential travel will be permitted during the late night/overnight hours.
- The City of Hallandale Beach is requiring all condominium associations to take actions in the
  interest of protecting public health and safety on their private property. This includes any efforts
  to discourage residents from using swimming pools and congregating in common areas. Please
  remember the CDC's guidelines advise against any groups larger than 10 people.
- All questions concerning City Inspections should be addressed to our City of Hallandale Beach hotline at (954) 457-1489.
- Seniors and those who are not comfortable with technology may hear news from Hallandale Beach read in English and Spanish on our new Senior VIP Listen Line at (954) 457-1477. Messages are updated regularly. You may also hear emergency information on your AM Radio by tuning in to AM 1620.
- Residents who wish to be tested for COVID-19 at the CB Smith Park location at Pembroke Pines
  must make an appointment BEFORE going to the park. Memorial Health requests you call to
  make an appointment at (954) 276-4680. This testing site is only for people who are at risk and
  showing symptoms.
- If you wish to visit the testing site at Hard Rock Stadium at the county line, please call (305) 499-8767 to make an appointment.
- Broward County has issued <u>Executive Order 20-01</u> Sunday evening, March 22, 2020, closing all non-essential retail and commercial businesses county wide at 12:01am Monday morning March 23, 2020. Essential businesses may remain open including grocery stores, banks, Doctor's offices, etc.
- The City of Hallandale Beach is operating under an <u>Emergency Declaration 20-2</u> issued on March 17th which includes a restriction for on-premise food and beverage service allowing for delivery and take out services only, the closing of all gathering/ entertainment facilities including bowling alleys, playhouses, arcades, gymnasiums or fitness centers with some exceptions, and continuing the prohibition of gatherings of any type of 250 or more people, beach closures, and cancellation of all City meetings, events, programs, and services until further notice.
- The City will be hosting a drive thru <u>emergency food distribution</u> at <u>Peter Bluesten Park</u> on Thursday, March 26th starting at 11am in partnership with Feeding South Florida. First Come,

First Serve. Please enter line at SE 7th St off US 1. Do not get out of your car, we will load the food in the trunk for you. Please have your trunk clean and empty. Another food distribution is planned for April 1, 2020. If you or your family have an immediate need, please call **(954) 457-1489.** 

- April 1st City Commission Meeting is cancelled. There are no time sensitive items that require
   City Commission approval. Next anticipated City Commission Meeting will be April 15.
- The United Way of Broward has informed the City's Human Services staff that there is no Census task Force meeting until April. United Way will potentially assist feeding HB seniors once they are mobilized.
- Residents who are currently not participating in a meal program and are experiencing a food shortage due to COVID-19, can call the Area Agency on Aging of Broward's Elder Helpline at 954-745-9779 for assistance.
- The City will continue normal operations of Water, Wastewater, Sanitation, and Police services. Trash, Recycling, and Bulk pick up continue to follow the regular <u>schedule</u>.
- BSO Fire Rescue will continue to provide Fire Rescue services as normal.
- The moratorium on water utility shut-offs in place for residential homes continues until further notice.
- o ALL Park Facilities, including Parks, Centers, Pool, Cemetery, and the Beaches, will remain closed until further notice.
- All events hosted by the City for the month of March and April are postponed until further notice. This includes all advisory board meetings.
- Mini busses are running on their <u>regular schedule</u> and are undergoing enhanced cleaning procedures to maintain a safe environment for riders. If you use our mini-bus, please practice social distancing.
- Broward County Libraries, including the Hallandale Beach Branch, are closed. For more information please visit <u>Libraries</u>.
